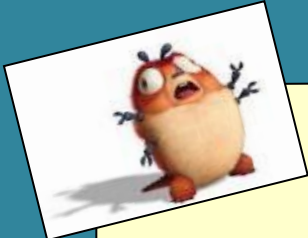
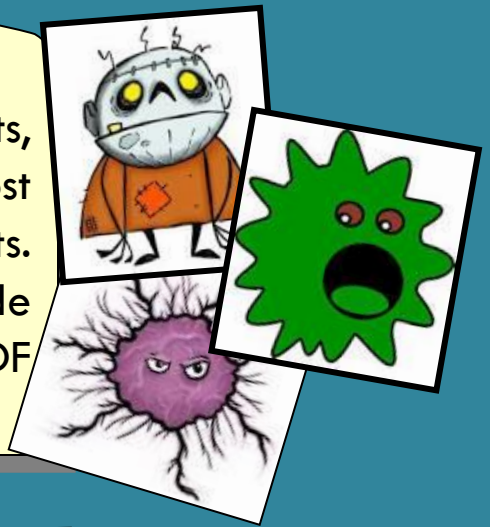


Document Malware
