Automatic shifting of slide to next slide

- 1. Select slide of your PowerPoint Presentation.
- 2. Click the Animations tab from the PowerPoint ribbon, and then locate Advance Slide Group.



3. On Advance Slide Group, untick 'On Mouse Click' then tick 'Automatically After'.




4. Set the time before the slide will appear.




5. Apply same steps for the rest of the slide.

Automatic shifting to next content of a slide.


- 1. Select the content of the slide on which you would like to add an effect.
 - 2. Click Add Effect button under Custom Animation Window Pane



3. Select the effect that you want to apply



4. Under Modify: Checkerboard, on "Start:" dropdown listbox, select how the content will start to appear.
