This will **disable** the magnifier tool and change the mouse pointer to an **insertion point marker** (or **I-beam**), similar to what you use and see in Normal view.

When the pointer changes from a magnifying glass to an I-beam, you can now make your changes to the document.





When you are in a Print Preview and you are about to print your document but need to edit a part of your document, instead of shifting back and forth between the Normal view and Print Preview, try editing in the Print Preview! Though simple, when accumulated, might save a lot of your time.
