SmartArt Overview in PowerPoint 2007 (Part 2)

SmartArt is a new feature allowing you to create simple and effective diagrams or charts, with additional options than in the past versions of PowerPoint.

Below are the lists of *SmartArt graphic styles* and their definitions that you can use in your presentations.

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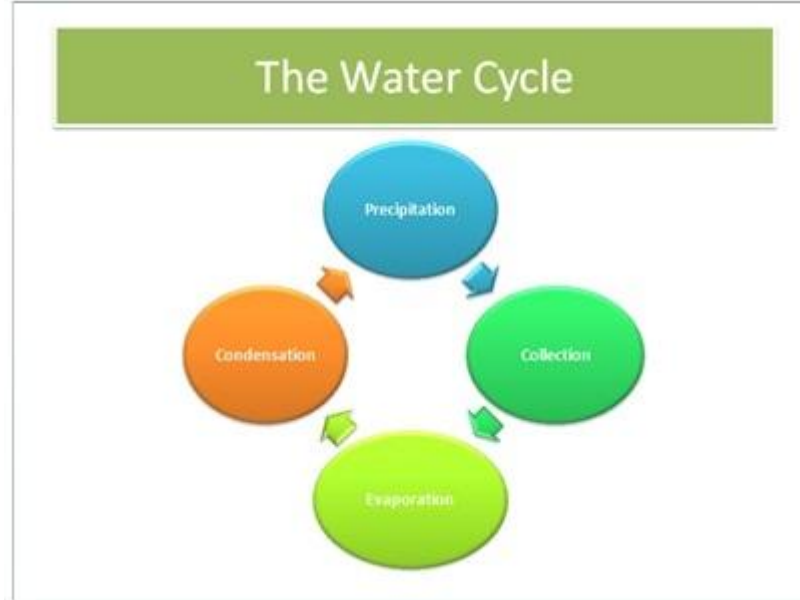
- A. **SmartArt List Graphic Styles:** The *Vertical Chevron List SmartArt* as shown below, is one of the many list graphic types that allows you to divide your topic points into sections.



- B. **Process SmartArt Graphic Styles:** Process graphics can show progression or sequential steps in a task, process, workflow or timeline. The example below is a *Continuous Picture List* showing groups of interconnected information. Hyperlinks could be added to each section to link to a specific slide or website about the information.



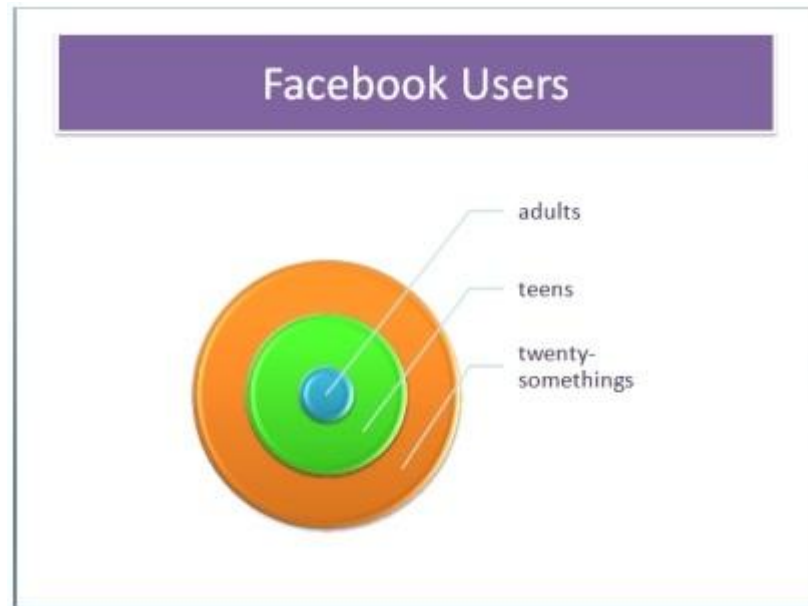
C. **Process SmartArt Graphic Styles:** Choose from continuous cycles or multi-directional cycles to show the sequences of tasks or flow of events or use a Venn type of cycle to show overlapping relationships to the central idea.



D. Hierarchy SmartArt Graphic Styles: Hierarchy SmartArt graphics can show anything from the structure of your company to your own personal family tree.



E. **Relationship SmartArt Graphics:** Use the Relationship type of SmartArt graphic to show how items or groups of items are connected to the central theme. Other relationships can show interrelated or overlapping information. Example below using the *Basic Target* type of relationship SmartArt has much more impact than bulleted text to show the number of Facebook users by different age groups.



F. **Matrix SmartArt Graphic:** The Matrix type of SmartArt graphic is used to show the relationship of four quadrants of a whole. In the example below, the four main departments of the company are illustrated.



G. Pyramid SmartArt Graphics: Pyramid SmartArt graphic shows proportional, interconnected or hierarchical relationships. In the example below, using the *Inverted Pyramid SmartArt*, the company growth has greater visual effect than numbers or percentages.
